Inglese N.2 New York City. Manhattan *One and a half million people live on this 34 square mile island (55 km²), where rents are the highest in the nation. It is not difficult to get around Manhattan because most streets run east to west and avenues run north to south. Lower Manhattan and its busy financial center, with Wall Street and the New York Stock Exchange, is the oldest part of the city. Ground Zero, where the Twin Towers were before they were destroyed in a terroristic attack in 2001, is in this area. Chinatown, a crowded, lively neighborhood, is the city's largest ethnic community. Like most ethnic communities, Chinatown is like a village in the middle of the the big city, where people still know each other by name. [...] Manhattan's Little Italy is next to Chinatown, with its forty or more Italian restaurants and caf  s and old world atmosphere.*

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Inglese N.3 Chicago. The Hearth of the Midwest. Chicago, Illinois is the largest city in the Midwest, and the third largest in the United States with almost three million people. The city, which is the hearth of business and industry in the Midwest, was built on the shore of Lake Michigan, America's biggest lake. It is often called the "windy city" because of the strong winds that blow across the city from the lake. The famous American poet Carl Sandburg called Chicago the "City of the Big Shoulders" because Chicago has always done things in a big way: it has the nation's busiest airport, O'Hare; the tallest skyscraper, the Sears Tower; the largest convention center, McCormick Place, and during the first part of the twentieth century it had the nation's biggest meatpacking industry. The name Chicago comes from the American-Indian word Checagou, which means wild onion, a plant which exists in large quantities in the area.

Inglese N.4 New Orleans and Dixieland Jazz. The blues is a kind of African-American folk music and a lot of modern American popular music developed from it. The earliest blues was vocal music, without any musical instruments, which the slaves used when they were working on plantations of the South. Their calls and shouts turned into beautiful but sad songs. Then the blues was mixed with the Christian spiritual songs of African-American churches and this developed into gospel music. Early street jazz started in Congo Square in New Orleans in 1835 when slaves met on Sundays to play music and dance. They were allowed to express themselves through music and dance and considered this kind of music an expression of freedom. Brass marching bands were a common tradition in New Orleans long before jazz music started and by 1838 they were on every street corner. These colorful brass bands performed during funerals, Mardi Gras, parades and other social events.

Inglese N.5 New Orleans. Mardi Gras. America's great writer Mark Twain once said, "... an American has not seen the United States until he has seen Mardi Gras in New Orleans." Mardi Gras in New Orleans is one of the most famous carnival celebrations in the world and attracts over a million visitors every year. The date of Mardi Gras changes from year to year, but always falls between February 3 and March 9. Mardi Gras, the French term for "fat Tuesday", started in 1700s as a Christian festivity and today it has its own flag and colors: purple, green and gold. The city is beautifully decorated for the event and everyone takes part in the fun. Although Mardi Gras is a particular day, the term includes a much longer period of celebrations that leads up to that day. The Carnival season includes amazing parades, beautiful costumes, live music, masked balls, dancing and fun in the streets.

Inglese N.6 New Orleans. The French Quarter The French Quarter with its narrow streets is also known as the Vieux Carré ("old square" in French); it is the site of the original settlement. It is a National Historic Landmark and was hardly touched by hurricane Katrina because of its location. Lovely houses of different colors with cast-iron balconies and exotic plants, trees and flowers show French, Spanish and Creole architecture. The French Quarter's central plaza is Jackson Square, with the statue of Andrew Jackson, an American hero of the War of 1812, and St Louis Cathedral, built in 1974. [...] The French open-air market, with its European flavor, was set up in 1791 and is the oldest public market in the United States; here you can buy fruit, vegetables, souvenirs and clothing. At the western end of the French Quarter is Canal Street, which divides the Quarter from the city's business district.

Inglese N.7 Los Angeles. Hollywood - When people think of Los Angeles the first thing that comes to mind is Hollywood and its movie stars and rock idols. The best place to see more than 2,000 five-pointed stars is the Hollywood Walk of Fame, a sidewalk along Hollywood Boulevard and Vine Street. Inside each pink star on the sidewalk is the name of a celebrity – usually an actor, actress, singer or dancer but the cartoon character Mickey Mouse has a star too! Grauman's Chinese Theater, which looks like a red Chinese pagoda, is Hollywood's most famous movie theater with almost 200 handprints, footprints and autographs of Hollywood stars in the cement in front of the theater. Visitors like looking for their favorite star's handprint or footprint and touching it. Another famous Los Angeles theater is the beautiful Kodak Theater, built in 2001. This 3,332-seat theater hosts the important Academy Awards event, when the best actors, actresses, directors and costume designers receive the Oscar.

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Inglese N.8 Los Angeles. Inglese N.9 Chicago. The Prohibition The period of American Prohibition started in 1920 and ended in 1933. During the Prohibition it was illegal to produce, transport or sell alcoholic drinks in the United States. But it was not illegal in nearby country like Canada and Mexico, so some Americans started importing them illegally into the country. Chicago became America's bootlegging center; dangerous gangster like Al Capone and his enemy Bugs Moran made millions of dollars. By 1930 Al Capone controlled the huge bootlegging business from Canada to Florida. Murders and shootings were common. The 1920s, known as the Roaring Twenties, was a period of major industrial growth, prosperity and social change. It was also a time of great musical creativity. The great number of new jobs in Chicago attracted many African-Americans from the southern states. During the 1960s upper- and middle-class people began leaving the city for the suburbs, which was common in many cities across the nation.
